Staller concentrates on Classical, Brazilian, Argentine, Flamenco, and other regional guitar styles. He performs frequently throughout the Bay Area and around the country in venues such as the Valley Forge Convention Center and the Kennedy Center in Washington D.C. Besides performing as a soloist and in ensembles, he has accompanied renowned vocalists, instrumentalists, and dancers. He teaches guitar, theory, and piano and is currently writing instructional books and videos for both guitar and ukulele. He is the founder of the East Bay Guitar Society.
